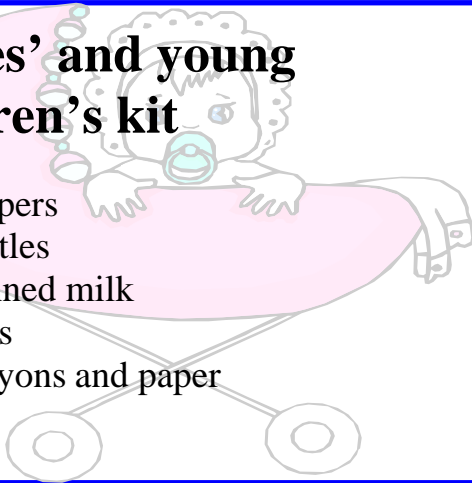


Emergency kit (suite)

Babies' and young children's kit

- diapers
- bottles
- canned milk
- toys
- crayons and paper



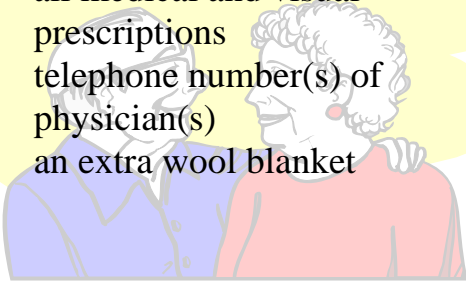
Children's kit

- a warm sweater
- woollen socks
- walkman and spare batteries
- games
- crayons and paper
- personal objects (photos, teddy bear, etc.)
- books



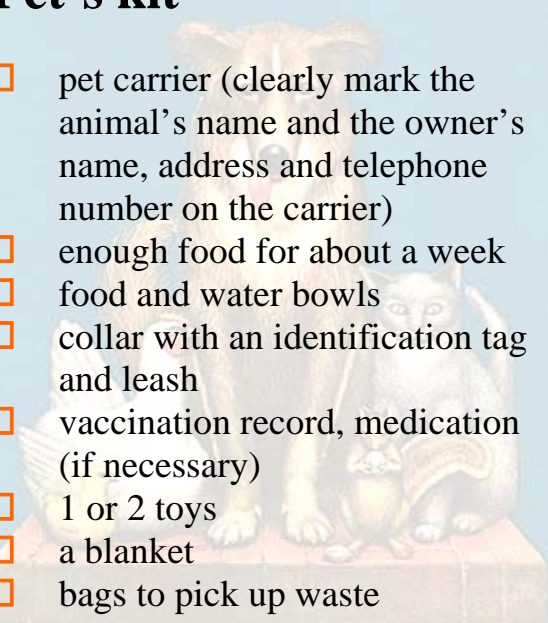
Elderly person's kit

- all medical and visual prescriptions
- telephone number(s) of physician(s)
- an extra wool blanket



Pet's kit

- pet carrier (clearly mark the animal's name and the owner's name, address and telephone number on the carrier)
- enough food for about a week
- food and water bowls
- collar with an identification tag and leash
- vaccination record, medication (if necessary)
- 1 or 2 toys
- a blanket
- bags to pick up waste



Car Kit

- shovel
- sand, salt or cat litter
- traction bands
- towing chain
- compass
- rag and paper towel
- warning lamp or flares
- a spare set of clothing and shoes
- emergency food
- an axe or hatchet
- booster cables
- scraper and brush
- road maps
- matches and candles in a tin box or plastic bag (can be used to warm hands, heat drinks or provide light)
- fire extinguisher
- methanol (to defrost fuel lines and windshield)
- flashlight and batteries
- first aid kit with shears for safety belts
- a blanket
